Dear Parents/Carers

Updated guidance and advice on living with COVID-19 issued by the Government has now come into effect.

This guidance states:

- Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school when they no longer have a high temperature and they are well enough to attend.
- Children and young people aged 18 and under with a **positive COVID-19 test** result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days, which is when they are most infectious.

Therefore, there is no longer a requirement for anyone who tests positive to complete 10 days isolation if they continue to test positive. Nor is it a requirement for two consecutive negative LFDs to end isolation early.

We ask all parents/carers to follow the guidance in the bullet points above to determine when their child can attend school.

We will continue to have measures in place in school to minimise risk of transmission, where possible.
